<u>DAYS</u>	<u>DESCRIPTIONS</u>	<u>DIVES</u>
FRIDAY	<p>Check-in on board of the Mermaid I approximately 4.p.m rite in front of our dive resort in Tulamben. Later after checking equipment and first briefings, dinner will be served on board and we will cruise overnight to Moyo Island.</p>	
SATURDAY	<p>Your first day of diving will be around Moyo and Satonda, where we will have 4 dives. Two at Moyo then we proceed to Satonda where we have one day and one night dive. After dinner we cruise to Gili Banta Island.</p>	4
SUNDAY	<p>The morning, which everyone is waiting for, we will check in at the Komodo National park and combine that with a walk to the Dinosaur's, the Komodo Dragons. After we will have a late morning dive at to the famous Horse Shoe bay. And continue the day with dives the Cannibal Rock and Tanjung Nusa Kode. A nightdive will be done at the Cannibal Rock.</p>	4
MONDAY	<p>Here you will spend the morning 2 dives, one northeast and one northwest Banta island. After lunch we go to the famous GPS Point. There will be a good chance of seeing Hammerheads.</p>	4
TUESDAY	<p>After breakfast you will make your first dive at the Yellow Wall of Texas. After this dive we cruise to the Alley. This spot is known for it's Manta Rays. The third dive of the day is at The End of the World. Here you have a good chance to see pelagics.</p>	4
WEDNESDAY	<p>Today we leave the Komodo National Park after the third dive, So we leave early in the morning heading for Pillarsteen. The second spot will be Pantai Merah Kecil. Dive number three of the day is at Gili Lawah Laut.</p>	4

After the last dive we will cruise to BIMA port, where we will have a short stopover and then cruise to Satonda.


THURSDAY

On the way to Tulamben we will stop in Satonda to do our last dives. Four more spectacular dives will wait here for you, before we are heading back overnight to Tulamen.

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FRIDAY

After breakfast you will check out and have a warm welcome in our resort, where you either check-in your room or continue your journey to

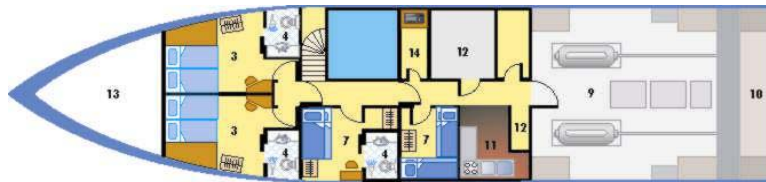

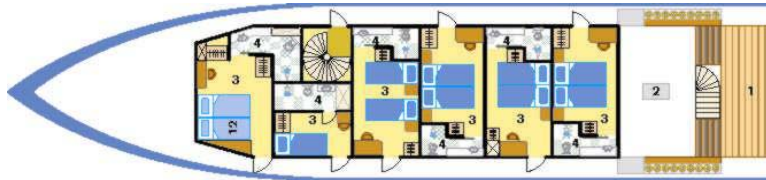

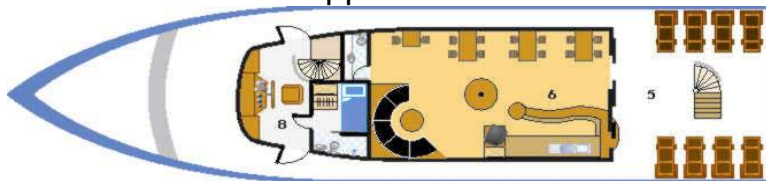
